



Lothian Ski Racing Privacy Policy

LSR will be a “controller” of the personal information that you provide to us.

When you register as a member of LSR or renew your membership (including if you are registering or renewing on behalf of a child under the age of 18), we will ask you for the following personal information:

- Contact details – name, address, telephone numbers, email address, date of birth, qualifications (coaches only) and personal development plans;
- Medical information – details of any medical treatment you are currently receiving, details of any regular medication you are currently taking, likelihood of requiring assistance or special treatment for any reason, medical or otherwise.

Why we need your personal information – contractual purposes

We need to collect our members’ personal information so that we can manage your membership with LSR. We will use our members’ personal information to:

- Provide you with core member services including insurance via LSRs membership with Snowsports Scotland (SSS).
- Send you membership communications by email in relation to essential membership services, including but not limited to, membership renewals and information on membership benefits.

If you do not provide us with all of the personal information that we need to collect then this may affect our ability to offer the above membership services and benefits.

Why we need your personal information – legitimate purposes

We also process our members’ personal information in pursuit of our legitimate interests to:

- Promote and encourage participation in the sport of skiing by sending members’ communications and booking information for upcoming training sessions, competitions and events. Our training sessions, competitions and events may be filmed or photographed, your personal information may also be used in images captured from our training sessions, competition and events, which we use for promotional, education and development purposes;



- Provide competition in the sport of skiing by accepting and managing entries for our competitions and checking your personal information to ensure you are entered into the correct category;
- Develop and maintain our members' and coaches qualifications, including sending email communications to inform you of upcoming courses, renewal requirements and verify that you have completed any mandatory training and PVG/child protection requirements; and
- Respond to and communicate with members and coaches regarding your questions, comments, support needs or complaints, concerns or allegations in relation to the sport of skiing. We will use your personal information to investigate your complaint, suspend membership and take disciplinary action where appropriate.

Where we process your personal information in pursuit of our legitimate interests, you have the right to object to any of the above processing, please contact us at membership@lothianskiracing.co.uk. If we agree and comply with your objection, this may affect our ability to undertake the tasks above for the benefit of you as a member.

Why we need your personal information – legal obligations

We are under a legal obligation to process certain personal information relating to our members for the purposes of complying with our obligations under the Protection of Vulnerable Groups (Scotland) Act 2007 to check that our coaches and volunteers are able to undertake regulated work with children and vulnerable adults.

Other uses of your personal information

We may ask you if we can process your personal information for additional purposes. Where we do so, we will provide you with an additional privacy notice with information on how we will use your information for these additional purposes.

Who we share your personal information with

We may be required to share personal information with statutory or regulatory authorities and organisations to comply with statutory obligations. Such organisations include the Health & Safety Executive, Disclosure Scotland, and Police Scotland for the purposes of safeguarding children.

We may also share personal information with our professional and legal advisors for the purposes of taking advice.



As an affiliated club of Snowsports Scotland, we are required to ensure that all of our members are members of SSS as a condition of affiliation.

We will also share:

- your name and year of birth with GBSki for the purposes of organising races including but not limited to generation of acceptance and start lists, race results and seeding information. GBSki will become a controller of your personal information when they receive it;
- Your email address with PayPal for the purposes of generating invoices. PayPal will become a controller of your personal information when they receive it.

In the event that we do share personal information with external third parties, we will only share such personal information strictly required for the specific purposes and take reasonable steps to ensure that recipients shall only process the disclosed personal information in accordance with those purposes.

How we protect your personal information

Your personal information is stored on a Google drive and is accessed only by coaches and volunteers for the purposes set out above. You can view Google's own Privacy Policy [here](#). A backup copy of your personal information is stored on an excel spreadsheet which is only accessible by our membership secretary.

How long we keep your personal information

We will only keep your personal information for as long as necessary to provide you with membership services. Unless you ask us not to, we will review and possibly delete your personal information where you have not renewed your membership with us for 3 years.

Your rights

You can exercise any of the following rights by writing to us at membership@lothianskiracing.co.uk.

Your rights in relations to your personal information are:

- You have the right to request access to the personal information that we hold about you by making a “subject access request”;
- If you believe that any of your personal information is inaccurate or incomplete, you have a right to request that we correct or complete your personal information;



- You have a right to request that we restrict the processing of your personal information for specific purposes; and
- If you wish us to delete your personal information, you may request that we do so.

Any requests received by LSR will be considered under applicable data protection legislation. If you remain dissatisfied, you have a right to raise a complaint with the Information Commissioner's Office at www.ico.org.uk.
